- Uphold school policies and Christian values in words and actions.
- Provide a safe, respectful, and productive learning environment.

When Serving as a student support substitute:

- Assist the teacher in classroom instruction, activities, and supervision.
- Work one-on-one or in small groups with students needing additional support.
- Help prepare materials, clean up, and organize the classroom.

- Supervise students during recess, lunch, or transitions as needed.
- Support before/after school programs as assigned.

- Experience working with children in educational settings.
- Ability to use classroom technology (e.g., projectors, tablets, educational software, learning platforms).
- Strong communication and interpersonal skills.
- Ability to follow instructions and adapt to different classroom environments.
