KINGSPPOINT CHRISTIAN SCHOOL CONCILIATION AGREEMENT:

I agree to follow the Biblical pattern of Matthew 18:15-17 and Galatians 6:1. All differences are to be resolved by utilizing Biblical principles. Appropriate confidentiality will be observed regarding student, parent, and school matters. (Titus 3:2 and Galatians 5:15).

If resolution of the dispute and reconciliation do not result from such efforts, the matter shall then be submitted to a panel of three arbitrators for binding arbitration. Each party to the agreement shall then have the right to select one neutral, third arbitrator. If there is an impasse in the selection of the third arbitrator, the Association of Christian Conciliation Services shall be asked to provide the name of a qualified person conducted in accordance with the Rules of Procedure for Christian Conciliation of the Association of Christian Conciliation Services - (409) 256-1583.

The parties agree that these methods shall be the sole remedy for any controversy or claim arising out of the relationship or this agreement and expressly waive their right to file a lawsuit against one another in any civil court for such disputes, except to enforce a legally binding arbitration decision. Each party, regardless of the outcome of the matter, agrees to bear the cost of his/her/its own arbitrator and any other arbitration expense.

(References to Matthew 18:1-5, Galatians 6:1, Titus 3:2, Galatians 5:15)
